

Let's Go Shopping: June

Question 1: Yolanda had \$47.85 when she went to the store. When she came home, she had \$14.93. How much money did she spend?

Answer 1: Subtract the amount she has left from the amount she had when she went to the store. Here's how to do that:

$$\begin{array}{r} \$47.85 \\ - 14.93 \\ \hline \$ 32.92 \end{array}$$

Yolanda spent \$32.92.

Question 2: Mr. Augustine went grocery shopping for his family. He took \$94.37 with him, and he came home with \$ 5.06. How much did she spend?

Answer 2: Subtract the amount he has left from the amount he had when he went to the store. Here's how to do that:

$$\begin{array}{r} \$94.37 \\ - 5.06 \\ \hline \$89.31 \end{array}$$

Mr. Augustine spent \$89.31.

Question 3:

Teresa walked to the corner store. She took \$10.00 with her, and she came home with \$4.58. How much did Teresa spend?

Answer 3: Subtract the amount she has left from the amount she had when she went to the store. Here's how to do that:

$$\begin{array}{r} \$10.00 \\ - 4.58 \\ \hline \$ 5.42 \end{array}$$

Teresa spent \$ 5.42.
